**Dan Mummert, the Wildlife Biologist for the PA
Game Commission's southeast region**, will provide
interesting facts and talk about the identification, distri-
bution, habitat requirements, and food preferences of
PA's eight species of owls. Dan will
also talk about a specific project
called the **Barn Owl Conservation
Initiative** which strives to conserve
this rare and declining owl species in
PA.

Before working for the Game Com-
mission, Dan worked as a wildlife
biologist in California, Utah, Arizona,
Maryland, and Delaware. He has a
Master's degree in Wildlife Biology
and Forestry from Northern Arizona University and an
Entomology degree from the University of Delaware.
